

PSAT/NMSQT Registration Payment Form 2009-2010

The PSAT/NMSQT measures skills important for success in college – verbal reasoning, critical reading, writing, and math problem-solving. Taking the PSAT/NMSQT enables students to:

- Get feedback about crucial academic skills
- Seek information from colleges
- Enter scholarship competitions (11th grade)
- Practice for SAT Program tests

NMSC Scholarship Programs: The 2009 PSAT/NMQST is the qualifying test for entry to the National Merit Scholarship Corporation (NMSC) competitions for college scholarships that will be awarded in 2010. Students who meet published participation requirements, which include taking the PSAT/NMSQT in the specified year (usually the junior year), will enter NMSC competitions for recognition and awards. Information about NMSC programs, entry requirements, and scholarships to be offered in 2009-2010 can be found at www.nationalmerit.org and in the 2009-2010 PSAT/NMSQT Student Bulletin that will be sent to schools this fall.

TEST DATE: Wednesday, October 14, 2009

FEE : \$21.00 (unused tests cannot be returned and therefore the fee is non-refundable.)

STUDENTS WITH DISABILITIES: College Board Services for Students with Disabilities (SSD) Eligibility Forms for Students without active SSD Eligibility Codes, or who are new to the school, must be submitted by September 9, 2009. No SSD Eligibility Forms will be accepted for the PSAT/NMSQT with, or after, the return of answer sheets. Eligibility must be approved by the College Board prior to testing.
