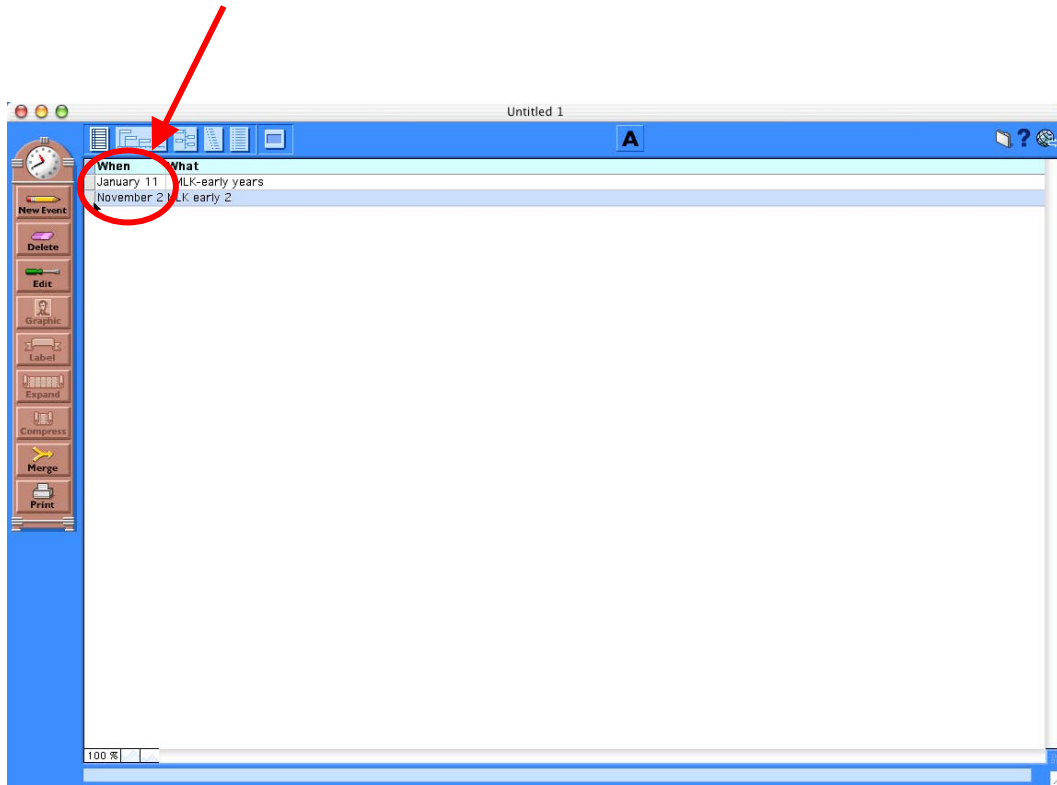


Timeliner 5.0[®] and unitedstreaming's QuickTime Videos

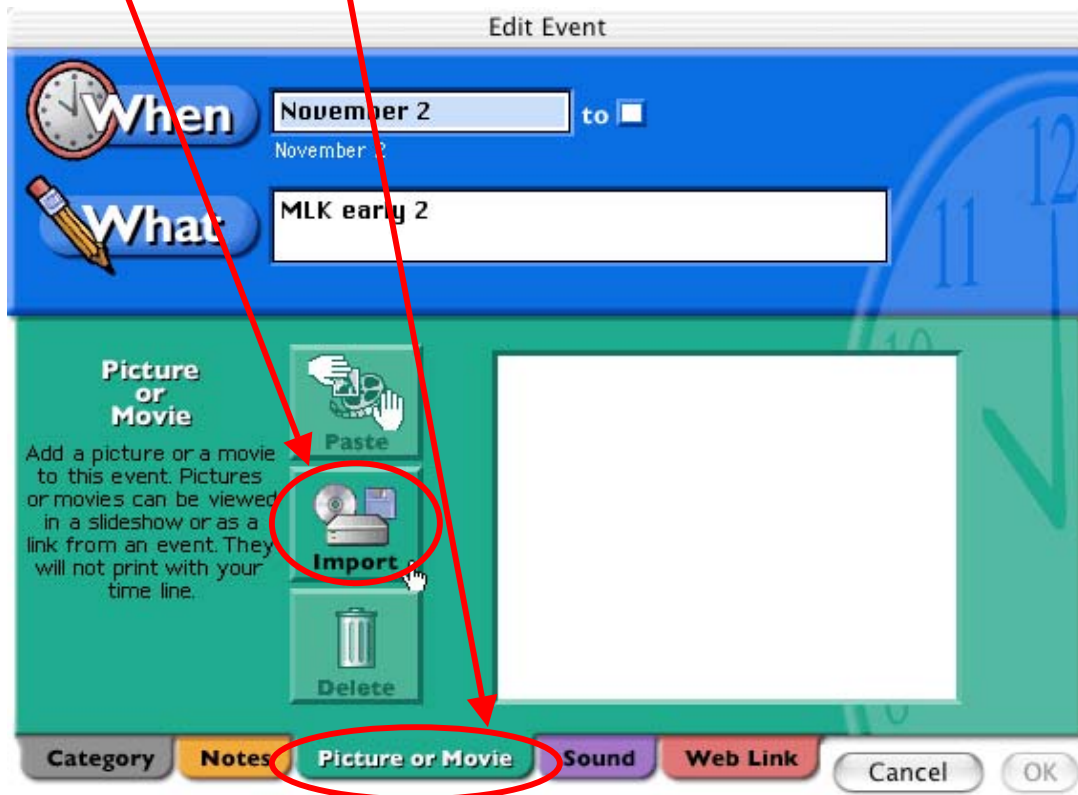
This tutorial was created with Timeliner 5.0, Macintosh OSX, and Microsoft OS 2000. (Currently, Windows Media Player files are not recognized).

To insert QuickTime Clips into your Timeline, simply follow the steps below.

1. Download and save your video clips in a designated folder.
2. Create a timeline with your dates and events.
3. Double click the gray box to the left of your date.

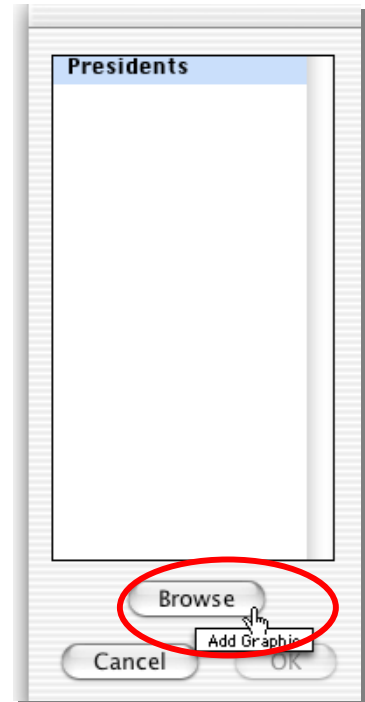
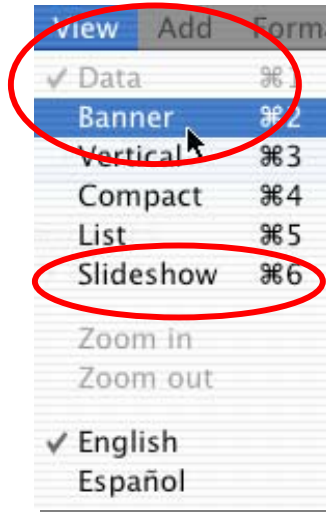


4. Click "Picture or Movie."
5. Click "Import."



6. Click "Browse" and navigate to select your QuickTime clip.

7. Go to "View" and "Banner", "Slide Show" or click the slide show icon in your navigation bar.



In Banner View:

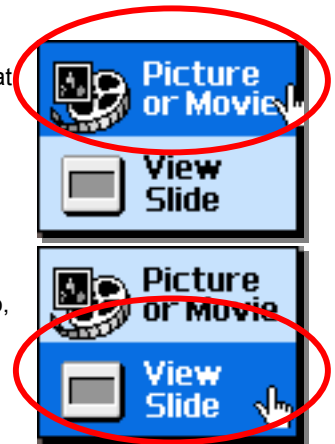
Click the "+" key to the left of your event and select one of the following two options.

Option 1: "Picture or Movie"

Select "Picture or Movie" to play your video. When the video appears, select the "play" icon at the bottom of the video play screen (the triangle symbol). When finished, click anywhere outside the video screen.

Option 2: "Slide"

Select the "slide" option. The video will appear in a separate "slide" or window. You will see the event and date at the top of the video and the timeline below the video. To play the video, click the "Play" button (triangle symbol). To go back to your regular timeline, click "Done" in the bottom right corner.



In "Slide Show" view:

Select your parameters to the video. Click "Run Slideshow." When finished, hit the Esc key.
