Part I: The Basics

1. Go to www.unitedstreaming.com
2. Your username: first initial, lastname.pusd
Your password: poway
3. Click on Preferences at the top of the Welcome line.
 - a. Go to the tab that is labeled "My Home Page"
 - b. Personalize your page, this will allow United Streaming to help you find videos that are appropriate for your curriculum
 - c. When you are finished, refresh your page so that you can see the changes that you have made

4. Find the segment on your homepage that says "Today in History", what does it say? Label the subject and tidbit:

7. Find the Subject/Grade Search. Are there any videos that you would be interested in using with your curriculum for the opening of the school year? If so, save it to "My Content." **Note: by using the tabs, "Video Segments" instead of "Full video" you can maximize the use of your time by showing the essential parts of the video*

8. Go back to your Home Page. Use the search field to find a video of your choice. Will you use the entire video, or just segments from it? Which ones?

9. By saving the content to your folder, you have only saved the link to find it. It is best that you download the video and save it if you are planning to insert the video in another program to try and use for a later time.

10. Go back to your "Home" page; look to the "search" and "within" fields. Using your last topic, is there anything else available beside video?

Part II: Teacher Center

1. Find the "Teacher Center" link on the welcome line. Click on "Assignment Builder."
2. Create an assignment following the step by step instructions.
3. Link that assignment to www.learningpoint.org Test the link to make sure that your students would be able to access the assignment.
4. Go back to the "Teacher Center" link and create a quiz using the "Quiz Builder."

5. Look for a quiz that is already made, or create your own quiz based on the videos that you want your students to view.

6. Is this something that you would do during the regular school year? What is the value of having access to something like this? What are the drawbacks?
