2. RTI Presentation with Shelley Fuller:

Four Elements:

NCLB  
All Students  
Safety net  
Monitor progress with researched based intervention

Three Tiered:

Tier 1: Universal intervention for all students  
Tier 2: Targeted group of interventions for at-risk  
Tier 3: Intensive individual intervention

- Elementary schools closer to meeting this target than middle and high schools.
- Plan is to pilot next year at a few elementary schools.

Committee Reports:

Group 1:

- Quality review indicators being worked on for middle and high school.
- Survey sent out to sites on full inclusion /mainstreaming for elementary schools.
- Conflict Matrix Training for Master Scheduling for middle and high school.

Group 2:

- Filings for the 2<sup>nd</sup> quarter this year indicate that our ranking has dropped out of the top ten. We may be turning the corner.

Group 3: Curriculum:

- Continuing to look at Read Well and Step-up to Writing
- Curriculum subgroup would like to have a follow-up Q&A ½ day training for teachers on the new curriculum on the May Professional Growth Day
- Curriculum TOSA?
- Recommend ½ day curriculum training for returning teachers at the beginning of the year and full day training for new teachers.
- Learning Strategies: Curriculum is minimal. Could we access two current teachers who have written a Learning Strategies curriculum? Need some accountability that teachers will present curriculum and not just a study hall.

Paul Goldfinger Study Upcoming: Statewide experts on special education fiscal matters. Team to spend 2-3 days with SPED. Look at fiscal/programming issues and make recommendations. Cost \$25,000

Administrative Designee: Group had discussion on Administrative designee for non-contentious IEPs. North County Consortium Administrative Designee Packet shared. Must have SPED designation credential or Administrative credential to act as Admin. Designee. Criteria for selection in Poway was shared.
