



Mrs. Marks (Room#15) Supply List-Option 1

Here is a list of basic items that needs to be provided by the end of the first full week of school.

3 ring binder (1 inch is sufficient- no bigger than 1 1/2" to fit in desk)

Paper - wide ruled binder paper

Dividers

SMALL pencil box to hold smaller items and it needs to FIT in the student's desk

***Optional **USB 1-2 GB Flash drive** (this will be useful for saving projects for use in the classroom as well as the computer lab)

Due to the budget cuts, our small classroom supply budget has been significantly reduced. Therefore, we are asking in addition to the above basic items, for a **one time** classroom supply donation of **\$50.00 (or whatever amount you can donate)** per student. (This donation can be paid in full or can be paid in two installments. First \$25.00 due August, Second installment (\$25.00) due January.) (Cash or check made out to individual teacher).

This supply fee will cover all periodical magazines, school supplies (pencils, colored pencils, markers, glue, paper, journals, folders, ink cartridges, DVD's, photo developing, Kleenex, zip lock bags, band-aids, etc.), and Art and Craft supplies (paints, construction paper, poster paper, fabric, etc.) for the **entire school year**. You will not be asked to bring in any more money for school, art, and thematic project supplies (or to provide any school, thematic or art supplies) the rest of the 09/10 year.

Please note that the "supply" fee does **not** cover any field trip expenses that will incur during the school year (transportation, attendance fees). Donations will be requested for field trips as they will occur during the course of the year.
