

Changes to Course:

The experience at HP was the most applicable to the subjects, which I teach. We explored the Oasis project. It is designed to supply High School and elementary Schools with HP printing equipment. This allows the students to explore digital printing technology in the form of Posters, Books, and prints. The students learn about Graphic Communication and Business Management by running the sites and creating the projects for clubs and organizations campus wide. As a Graphic Communications teacher I was excited to learn about the program. I would encourage my future students to intern with the schools as a graphics guide with the High School students, encouraging them to look beyond the preset templates and create their own. I will show the students how to make color adjustments and think in large format and multiple page printing. This will directly apply to the 3 levels of Photoshop, which I currently teach.

Lesson Plans:

The students will be able to create project-based learning.

1. They will create a large format Poster adjusting for the "Dot Per Inch" resolution to match the printer that they will use.
2. They will explore the Dots Per Inch concept and compare it to LPI or Lines Per Inch traditional printing concept.
3. They will create their own unique graphic design.
4. They will identify the Target Market and discuss how they would market their idea to a large audience.
