

## **KNIT ONE, PURL TWO AND FELT THREE - Supply List**

### **TEACHER – Susan Hopkins**

This beginning knitting class is designed for those completely new to knitting or those with minimal experience wanting to improve your skills. In this class, you will create a hand-knit handbag and learn the art of felting. We begin with casting on and the simple knit stitch. You will learn how to pick up stitches around the base of your bag and perfect your stitch tension as you knit up the sides. Nearing the top, eyelet holes will be created and you will finish with an I-cord bind off. After I-cord handles are made, you will felt your bag. When you have completed this class, you will have the experience and confidence to advance to more challenging projects.

#### **SUPPLY LIST:**

(2) Skeins 100% wool. "Patons" Classic Wool is an excellent choice. It comes in 3.5 oz. skeins and is economical. You may use all the same colors or vary them for stripes. Your fiber must be 100% wool. Acrylic will not felt!

(1) Size 10 1/2 circular needle, 16" length. Do not purchase a 29" long needle! Stitches are too hard to tug around. "Michaels" does not carry the 10 1/2, 16" circular needle. "Joann's" has them and "The Antique Yarn Shop" has them or you may order them online.

(1) Package of Size 10 1/2 double-pointed needles (to do I-cord).

(1) Package of needle markers that fit up to a 10 1/2 needle. "Clover" makes packages of "Soft Stitch Ring Markers" that come in pink/blue or green/orange that fit needle sizes 0 to 11.

(1) Large blunt-eyed needle to darn in ends.

(1) Crochet hook, any size from G to J to pick up any dropped stitches.

(1) Scissors.
