

STUDENT COUNCIL ELECTION PROCESS AND SCHEDULE

- September 12
(Friday) Friday Flag
*Introduction of Offices and Requirements
- September 12
(Friday) Parental Permission Slips Distributed
- September 19
(Friday) Parental Permission Slips Due
*Teachers review for signature
*Teachers review for good citizenship approval
- September 19
(Friday) **CLASSROOM ELECTIONS**

*2 candidates per office, per room. Combo class - 1 candidate per grade level, per office
** **CANDIDATES** bring their permission slip to Mrs. Glover's room (room 5) after school at 12:40 for a **brief** meeting to receive the campaign / election schedule. **You must attend.***
- September 22
(Monday) *Campaign runs September 22-26
*Finalists may have one poster (24" by 36" or smaller)
*Hang your poster on the inside of the fence (facing in) at the Character Court (old lunch area). You may want to laminate your poster to protect it from sprinklers and dew.
*Finalists may have homemade badges (make sure all paper is picked up).
*No candy, gum, etc. may be given out; (anyone not following the rules will have their name removed from the ballot).
*Speeches for the Final Assembly on Friday, September 19 are 2 minutes maximum.
Mrs. Glover must approve speeches at the scheduled rehearsal or your name will be removed from the ballot.

- September 26

*Candidates report to MPR at 8:05 for 8:15 assembly
*Voting follows immediately after assembly
*Classroom election results need to be sent to Cathy Glover
Friday by 11:00.
*Teachers **MUST** count ballots, not students or parents
*All campaign posters must be down by the end of Election
Day. If not down by the end of the day they will be thrown
away.
*Candidates will meet in the Character Court (old lunch area)
near the end of the day to hear the election results.
- September 30-
October 3
(Tues. – Fri.) Classes elect Student Council Representative and one
alternate (or it can be two representatives)
