



STUDENT BICYCLE PERMIT

TO: Parents of Students in Grades 3 through 5:

We feel that responsible boys and girls in grades 3 through 5 who live a reasonable distance from school and have their parent's consent should have the privilege of riding their bicycles to and from school. We would like to point out the following regulations:

- Under the law, a bicycle is regarded as a vehicle and as such, the rider must obey all of the traffic laws that apply to any vehicle. (Riding on the right hand side of the road, using hand signals, etc.)
- Riding a bike requires wearing a safety helmet at all times.
- Only one rider is permitted on the bike AT ANY TIME.
- The bike is never to be ridden on the school grounds, but must be "walked" if it becomes necessary to move it from one area of the school grounds to another.
- Space is provided below for the bicycle's make, model, frame and serial number. Please fill in this information. If your child's bicycle should be stolen, this information will help in recovering and returning it to your child. IT IS NECESSARY TO COMPLETE THIS FOR EACH YEAR.
- Each bicycle should have a lock.
- The school assumes no responsibility for the bicycle or its accessories.
- The privilege of riding the bike may be suspended by the school if a child does not obey the above or other reasonable safety rules and regulations.
