

## Supplies for Band And Orchestra At OVMS

### Everyone needs the following

1. Binder
  - a. Black 3 ring binder
  - b. 30-50 plastic sheet protectors
  - c. ~40 pages of college lined notebook paper
  - d. Pencil with eraser
2. Books
  - a. 6<sup>th</sup> grade band
    - i. Band Expressions book 1
  - b. 6<sup>th</sup> grade orchestra
    - i. String Explorer book 1
    - ii. Strictly Classics book 1
  - c. Intermediate Band
    - i. Foundations for Superior Performance
    - ii. Band Expressions book 2
  - d. Advanced Band
    - i. Foundations for Superior Performance
  - e. Advanced Orchestra
    - i. Advanced techniques for Strings
3. Concert Attire
  - a. Boys:
    - i. Black slacks
    - ii. Black tie
    - iii. Black dress shoes
    - iv. Black socks
    - v. White button-up shirt
  - b. Girls
    - i. Black slacks or Skirt
    - ii. Black blouse
    - iii. Or Black dress
    - iv. Black trouser socks if you are wearing slacks
    - v. Black hose or tights if you are wearing a skirt or a dress
    - vi. Black dress shoes
4. Cleaning Material
  - a. Whatever your instrument needs to be kept clean
5. Case should be clearly labeled with your name and phone number
6. Band member optional supply :
  - a. Tuner
  - b. Metronome
7. Orchestra members are required to have a digital tuner. The metronome is optional.

## Supplies by Instrument

### Percussion

#### **REQUIRED\*\*\*\***

1. Continuous private lessons
2. Stick bag (with your name on it)
3. Yarn mallets
4. Drum sticks
5. Rubber Mallets
6. Timpani Mallets

\*\*\*\*\*#2-6 can be purchased as a package at a discounted rate at Bertrands Music on Black Mountain and Paseo Montalban or at Ozzie's Music at 12222 Poway Rd

### Brass

All brass instruments (trumpet, French horn, baritone, trombone, and tuba) need the following supplies:

1. Slide grease

#### **Trombones:**

1. small spray bottle with water in it
2. slide cream or oil

#### **Baritones, Trumpets, Tuba**

1. Valve oil

#### **French Horn**

1. Rotor Oil
2. Rotor string

### Reed Instruments (Clarinet, Oboe, Bassoon, Saxophone)

1. 3 working reeds at ALL TIMES in your case (remember you shouldn't use a reed for more than 2 weeks...mold and bacteria will make you sick and the reed loses its integrity)
2. Cork Grease

### Flutes

1. Just your cleaning materials....DO NOT: use key oil, submerge your flute in water, use silver polish, or cloths that contain polish (polish will get under your keys and gunk up your pads and while the flute may look shiny for a while it will slowly remove the finish off your flute and you will have a dull looking flute.) If you have sticky pads you can get pad paper at the music store or your **parents** can purchase cigarette paper at the convenience store (this absorbs moisture out of the pad).

### Strings (violin, viola, cello and bass)

1. Shoulder Rest (Violin and Viola) No sponges or wash cloths and EVERYBODY has to have a shoulder rest.
2. Extra set of strings in your case
  - a. Violins: at least your "A" and "E" strings
  - b. Violas and Cellos: at least your "D" and "A" strings
  - c. Bass: at least your "G" string
3. Rosin
4. Digital tuner (no pitch pipes)
5. Fine tuners (most violins, violas, cellos come with fine tuners, basses don't need them)
6. Wiping cloth

#### Optional String Materials:

1. Violin/viola/cello etc... finger board tape or fingerboard sticker and metronome.
