

STEP BY STEP CRF COMPLETION

12th graders are required to take a minimum of 5 classes. You must fill in all 6 spaces on the CRF, either with 6 classes or 5 classes + “off roll.” You must have 180 credits at the end of 11th grade in order to take a period of “off roll” in 12th grade.

The following information will guide you through each of the six required spaces that need to be completed in order for you to have an appropriate schedule next year. Be sure to complete the spaces for both first and second semesters.

CRF Space 1/English

Most students will choose World Literature 1-2, British Literature 1-2 or Expository Reading and Writing 1-2. If you select AP English Literature 1-2, a teacher signature is required on your CRF. All 4 choices are considered college prep.

CRF Space 2/Math

Two years of math are required for high school graduation. Three years is the common requirement for four-year college admission, **BUT** selective schools always recommend **FOUR** years of math. Write down the course number and name of the math class you wish to take. Included in this packet is the PHS math course sequence. Look at that chart and choose the logical next level of math you should take.

Ask your math teacher what the recommendation would be for your next math class.

CRF Space 3/Science

One year of physical science (Geoscience, Chemistry, Physics) **and** one year of life science (Biology, Zoology, Human Biology) are required for graduation and for 4-year college admission. Most 4-year colleges recommend completion of three years of science, typically biology, chemistry, and physics. If you wish to enroll in honors or AP levels of any science, you need a teacher recommendation. If you do not wish to take science and your basic requirement has been met you may fill in electives in this space.

CRF Space 4/Social Science

Check either Civics/Economics or AP Government/Economics 1-2. If you select AP Government/Economics, a teacher signature is required on your CRF. Either class is college prep.

CRF Space 5/World Language

World language is **not** a high school graduation requirement. However, four year colleges require a **minimum** of two years and many recommend **more** than two years. Choose the world language that is next in the sequence from the one you are taking now. If you decide **not** to take world language please put another elective and circle an additional five on the bottom of CRF course.

CRF Space 6/PE or Elective

The high school graduation requirement for PE is four semesters. There is no college requirement. Students may take up to eight semesters of PE during high school. If you still need PE or wish to take PE beyond the four semesters please write the number and name of the PE class you would most like to take, **but** circle four others on the PE list on the back of the CRF. PE classes or specific elective classes are never guaranteed to you. You may choose an elective that is not PE by listing the course number and title in the spaces provided. Please **circle five other electives** that you would find acceptable, as we cannot guarantee your first choice. If you do not circle five electives and the elective that you have chosen is not available to you we will assign one to you.
