HOURS AND ABSENCES:

ESS will continue to operate from 6:30 a.m.-6:00 p.m. during the school year. As stated in the ESS agreement, all students must be signed in and out by an authorized person (picture I.D. will be required). A late fee of \$1.00 per minute after 6:00 p.m. will be charged per child. Please notify us if your child will be absent. We are available by phone or email 24 hours a day.

MEDICATION:

If your child will need to take medication while at ESS, we must have an Authorization for Medical Administration form on file signed by both the physician and parent. Please have the proper forms along with the corresponding medication. We cannot accept medications without the proper paperwork. Your doctor can fax the completed forms directly to ESS. Please see Corinne or Kaitlyn for the correct forms and more information.

HOMEWORK TIME:

Grades 1-5 will have a homework time in ESS during the school year. If your child does not have homework, or finishes early, our staff will provide academic alternatives such as activity sheets, journal topics, and other brain teasers. In the upcoming weeks, staff will be meeting with the classroom teachers to understand the specific homework of each grade level. Also, in the next few weeks, parents will be receiving homework agreements for the parent and student to sign. The homework agreements will help parents and staff better understand the dynamics of homework time. We will also be sharing this information with your child's teacher.
