2009 Kindergarten Enrollment Information

Kindergarten enrollment for Park Village Elementary will **begin on Tuesday, May 12, 2008 from 2:30 p.m. to 5:00 p.m. in the MP Room**. Enrollment thereafter will be taken on a continuing basis between the hours of 9:30 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. in the school office. In order to be well prepared for the new school year, we would like all registrations before school closes in June. As there are several factors considered before placing a student in a class, priority is **not** given as to when a student registers. Also, we are unable to honor teacher or class time requests. Should there be an extenuating circumstance, there will be a form to fill out at the time of registration. Log into the Park Village Elementary Website, <http://www.powayusd.com/PUSDPVES/> and go to the "New Enrollment" tab on the home page and download the required enrollment forms and site specific forms. You will need to bring the completed forms with you when you come to enroll.

Requirements for Kindergarten Enrollment

- The child must be 5 years of age on or before December 2, 2009.
- Bring the original birth certificate, and we will make a copy of it.
- Bring two proofs of residency which we will make a copy of (i.e. Current SDG&E bill, cable bill, monthly bank statement that includes your name and address).
- Since the registration form asks for it, it would be handy to have your child's Social Security number with you.
- Bring your child's immunization card. **All immunizations need to be up to date.**

Immunization Requirements for Kindergarten Enrollment

POLIO 4 doses at any age but - 3 doses if last dose was given on or after 4th birthday

DTP 5 doses - 4 doses if last dose was given on or after 4th birthday

MMR 2 dose - Both given on or after 1st birthday

Hepatitis B 3 doses - 3 dose series

Varicella 1 dose or doctor documented verification that student had disease
