Dear Students and Parents,

The administration, faculty, and staff at Rancho Bernardo High School are dedicated to the primary mission of “all students learning – whatever it takes”. Our efforts are made more meaningful when we have a campus climate that avoids unnecessary distractions and encourages academic engagement. The RBHS dress code helps to create that climate.

In order to dress for student success, school clothing should be neat, clean, and follow standards of common decency and safety. Appropriate clothing guidelines include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Apparel must not promote or mention violence, drugs, alcohol, sexual references, or gangs.
2. Tops must be secured by straps.
3. “Muscle” undershirts are not allowed.
4. No bare midriffs.
5. Underwear/boxers must not be exposed.
6. Tops must not reveal cleavage or bra.
7. Skirts must be at least mid-thigh. (“Skorts” are defined as skirts).
8. Mini-shorts are not allowed.
9. No bandanas.
10. Shoes must be worn at all times.

If students arrive to school dressed inappropriately, parents will be notified and requested to bring different clothing to school. Students will not be allowed to return to class until they meet our dress code. Please see that your student is dressed appropriately when arriving at school to avoid missing class time.
