

2010 Music Scholarship Entry Guidelines

Instructions for Applying:

The guidelines below are to be followed exactly. There is no official form for this scholarship program. Entries not conforming to the specifications outlined below will be disqualified. Please read the following carefully:

1. Type all information on 8 1/2 x 11 sheets of paper.
2. Place your full name and address (including city, state, and zip code), and phone number on the top of each page submitted. Staple all sheets together. You may submit up to 4 pages.
3. List by name and year (9, 10, 11, 12) music leadership positions and offices held.
Example: Royal Regiment Officer (11)
Section Leader (12)
4. List by name and year the honors, awards, and scholarships applied for and received during high school.
Example: John Phillip Sousa Award (12)
Jr. Rotarian (11)
5. List by name and year any community involvement in which you have participated.
6. Prepare a 400-500 word essay explaining what your music education has meant to you.

ARMS Annual Scholarship

The purpose of the ARMS scholarship is to encourage appreciation of music through on-going participation and/or education. The ARMS Scholarship consists of a monetary award to one or more graduating instrumental (band and orchestra) music students. To qualify, applicants must plan to continue their music participation and/or music education at an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university.
