Dear Parents,

Modernization update: The beginning of the modernization of Sundance has been pushed back until March. It is now anticipated that the eight temporary classrooms that will be used during construction will be moved into place near the 1st of March, occupied midmonth with construction starting as soon as the buildings are vacated. There has also been a change in the phasing schedule with classrooms 1, 2, 14, 15, 17 and 18 being the first to be renovated. Prior to construction beginning the office will be relocated to a portable trailer in front of the multipurpose room. A significant change to the grounds is also in store for us in the next few weeks as the trees and shrubs which are to be replaced after construction are cut down and removed. This has to be done for the project to move forward.

There will be an opportunity for you to hear in more detail the plans for Sundance and the safety precautions which will be in place while the children are here. Please plan to attend the **PTA meeting on February 10th at 6:00 in the multipurpose room.**
