Please provide the following documents on enrollment day (unfortunately, we are not able to accept an enrollment packet with all of the documents listed below):

1. **Certified birth certificate:** Passport or baptismal certificate is acceptable, however, the hospital souvenir certificate and/or the request card to obtain the birth certificate is not.
2. **Two proofs of residency:** e.g., escrow papers, rental agreement, rent receipt, utility bills, bank statement, deed to home, property tax receipt (check books and drivers licenses are not acceptable).
3. **Social Security Card**
4. **Child Health and Disability Prevention (CHDP):** All students are required to have a specific physical examination when entering first grade. The Child Health and Disability Prevention (CHDP) examination may be obtained within 18 months prior to entering first grade. The pre-kindergarten physical qualifies if obtained within six months prior to entering kindergarten in August 2009. 5. **Oral Health Assessments** (dental screening) are now required for all children entering public school for the first time at either the kindergarten or first grade level.
6. **Immunization records:** Official immunization record with entries made by a physician or clinic. You must have the following immunizations to register:
  - Polio** – 4 doses at any age, but...3 doses meet the requirement if at least one was given after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
  - DPT** – 5 doses at any age, but... 4 doses meet the requirement if at least one was given after the 4<sup>th</sup> birthday.
  - MMR** (Measles, Mumps and Rubella) – 2 doses, both doses must have been given on or after the 1<sup>st</sup> birthday.
  - Hepatitis B** – 3 doses
  - Varicella** (Chicken Pox) – 1 dose or health care provided-documented varicella disease or immunity.
