5th Grade Supply List

Below is the supply list for 5th Grade

1 box #2 pencils*

2 extra fine point black sharpie* and 2 fine point black sharpie*
2 high- lighter markers
Eraser
Glue and glue sticks*
1 pair of scissors
Hand pencil sharpener
Ruler- standard/centimeter
Protractor
3 ring binder (1 inch is sufficient- no bigger than 1 1/2")
Paper - wide ruled binder paper*
2 Reams of white copy paper*
2 Reams of color copy paper (any color)
1 Ream of cardstock (white or colored)
Dividers
Markers, crayons, colored pencils*
1 Box of Kleenex
SMALL pencil box to hold smaller items and it needs to FIT in the student's desk
1 box of ziplock baggies (sandwich, snack or gallon size)
Composition book – 100 sheet count
Two Spiral notebooks standard ruled (2 different colors)
Three - double pocket folders
Tub of Baby Wipes, Antibacterial Wipes, or Hand Sanitizer
USB 8 GB Flash drive (or larger) (this will be useful for saving projects for use in the classroom as well as the computer lab)
1 pair of ear buds or ear phones. Please put in a baggie with your name on it.
