

REMEMBER...

WHEN YOU ARRIVE:

The following procedures are for swim lesson students and parent wishing to use the pool:



1. First and foremost, anyone who attends a class (swimmer, parent or legal guardian) may do so only if they are not ill or experiencing COVID-19 related symptoms of any kind.

The COVID-19 symptoms would include:

- Fever or chills
- Respiratory illness or breathing difficulty
- Cough
- Any other symptoms listed on the CDC website (<https://www.cdc.gov/coronavirus/2019-ncov/symptoms-testing/symptoms.html#seek-medical-attention>)

2. Arrive on time for your scheduled swim lesson and wait in the designated lesson area.

3. Swimmers will arrive and depart dressed in their suits.

4. The pool deck will be marked with cones and/or tape to direct the swimmers to their proper place and to control traffic around the pool.

5. Everyone allowed in the facility must wear some form of facial covering, unless for medical reasons. Face coverings shall not be worn when in the pool.

6. We will control access to/from the pool to minimize contact with others (either using different doors/gates or arrivals and departures at staggered intervals).

7. Swim instructors will teach swim lessons from the pool deck. For those children who require close contact for the lessons (or otherwise require an adult with them in the pool), parents must be in the water with their children and the swim instructor will teach on the pool deck.

8. At the conclusion of the swim lesson, no congregating. Exit the facility promptly so the next session of swimmers may enter.

9. During the lesson time, please stay in the designated area in which assigned to observe.

10. Hand sanitizers will be made available for all pool users.

11. Before coming to the pool, swimmers are expected to have their temperatures checked and must stay home if their temperatures are 100 degrees or more and/or have any symptoms associated with COVID-19.

12. Locker rooms and restrooms will be closed and locked, with use only for emergency toilet needs, which must occur one at a time and cleaned after use. The showers will be closed and not available for use.

13. Water Fountains will be off limits and will be covered. Swimmers must bring their own water bottle to participate.

14. At this time to minimize the number of people present, only one adult (parent or legal guardian) may accompany the swimmer and view the lesson. The adult must have completed the appropriate paperwork to attend. Adults in attendance must remain six-feet apart while viewing lessons.

15. The bleachers and deck will have markings to designate areas that they are able to sit and maintain social distancing. Face coverings must be worn at all times for those in attendance.

16. Patrons may bring in their own chairs for sitting on. There will be no community chairs.

17. The staff will follow the cleaning and disinfection procedures regarding the pool area and pool equipment pursuant to the CDC and local public health recommendations.

18. The Aquatics Program will make changes as necessary to comply with any changes to public health guidelines.
