#### ► **Local Control and Accountability Plan (LCAP) and Proposed 2017-18 Budget**

Thank you to all students, staff, parents, and community members who participated in the LCAP forums and surveys. District staff presented a first reading of PUSD's LCAP and proposed budget. PUSD's Five LCAP Goals remain:

Support high-quality teachers in their implementation of an articulated California standards-based curriculum, instruction, and assessment to ensure college and career readiness and citizenship for students, TK-12

Create systems and structures that provide multiple pathways of learning and engagement to increase college and career readiness of our students and close the achievement gaps for all subgroups

Strengthen and maintain a safe, healthy, positive, and attractive learning environment for all learners

Increase parent and student engagement in learning through enhanced community involvement in the education of our students

Develop, implement, and embed a collaborative learning structure and system for adults and students to increase student achievement

For the 2017-18 proposed total budget of \$369,611,563, \$329,051,678 (89%) will be directed toward meeting the five LCAP goals. Next steps include draft LCAP available for review and input.
