

FACILITY SECURITY

Physical security and safety of buildings and property of the district shall be maintained at all times. During school hours, responsible staff members shall take adequate steps to ensure that building spaces not in use are kept locked and that equipment is returned after use.

After school hours, responsible staff members shall ensure that equipment is properly stored and that all building spaces are properly closed and locked to minimize the opportunity for vandalism and theft.

The following are prohibited on district property: loitering; profane language; littering; climbing on buildings or fences; alcohol, drugs, or tobacco; dangerous objects; weapons of any type; explosives or explosive devices; wheeled devices such as bicycles, skateboards, skates, scooters, coasters, or motorized vehicles; dogs, horses, or other animals unless authorized by the site administrator or Director of Facilities, Maintenance, and Operations; model airplanes or rockets; hazardous materials; and any device or substance creating a fire risk. Dogs shall be allowed if required to aid the visually impaired.

Signage announcing these and related prohibitions may be posted on school sites according to specifications established by the Director of Facilities, Maintenance, and Operations.

Signage

All sites must have signs containing the following:

1. No tobacco, drugs, alcohol, firearms, or weapons of any type
2. No dogs, horses, or other animals
3. No skateboards, rollerblades, bicycles, motorcycles, or other wheeled devices
4. All visitors must check into the office during school hours
5. Use of fields is by permit only

All signs that function as traffic, legal notifications, or safety will be funded by Maintenance and Operations. All signs that are informative or directive and specific to school site will be funded (cost of sign plus installation) by the site. Site-funded signs that are vandalized will be replaced under vandalism funding.
