

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES FOR NON-SCHOOL COMMUNITY GROUPS

The Director of Transportation or designee shall screen all requests for transportation services. Non-school community groups will be provided services as determined by the Governing Board policy and Education Code limitations. Generally, these services will be limited to senior citizens groups, public parks and recreation organizations, church groups, and other similar not-for-profit groups and organizations.

The Director of Transportation or designee shall prepare estimates each year of charges based on a cost per mile to be used as a guideline in charging non-school community groups that are authorized to obtain transportation services. This cost per mile will not be used to determine final costs. Final costs shall be based on actual costs incurred by the district for providing these services. Costs shall include bus driver's salary and fringe benefits, fuel, maintenance, depreciation, insurance, and other operating costs, as deemed appropriate by the Director of Transportation.
