4.4 MANAGEMENT PERSONNEL

SECTION 4.415 VOLUNTEER ASSISTANCE

The Governing Board encourages parents and other members of the community to share their time, knowledge, and abilities with students. Volunteer assistance in schools enriches the educational program, enhances supervision of students, and contributes to school safety while strengthening the schools' relationships with parents and the school community. The Board also encourages community members to serve as mentors providing support and motivation to students.

The Superintendent, or designee, shall establish procedures to help protect the safety of students and adults. These procedures shall include laws related to tuberculosis testing and may also include laws related to criminal record checks. This policy prohibits sex offenders from volunteering in schools and requires completion of the Volunteer Acknowledgement and Notice of Amended Education Code Section 35021.

The Superintendent, or designee, shall periodically report to the Board regarding the District's volunteer assistance program.
