6.90 TECHNOLOGY STANDARDS

SECTION 6.90.4 Districtwide Computer Replacement

The Board of Education authorizes the Superintendent to manage and allocate District resources proactively in order to systematically replace a primary foundation of computers and supporting technology on a rotational basis at all school sites and District offices. Contingent upon budgetary allocations, the Superintendent shall authorize the replacement of a percentage of the school site and administration office base level of computers and related equipment. Base levels will be developed by staff and approved by the Superintendent's Cabinet.

The Board endorses the Districtwide replacement plan:

1. To provide all staff with access to technology equipment and resources needed to perform all District-required duties and provide the highest quality education for our students.
2. To promote communication between school staff and families regarding student achievement.
3. To provide staff, students, and parents with a high quality, stable, and consistent network environment to access online resources provided by the District.
4. To provide an ongoing, easily maintainable inventory to assist the District in making decisions about the allocation of technology resources.
5. To provide staff with the ability to use District assessments and resources effectively.

The District will advertise and award a bid to lease and/or purchase computers and related technology equipment.

If the computers are leased, at the end of the lease, the site will have the option to purchase any or all equipment with the understanding that the District shall determine whether this equipment will be permitted on the District corporate network, and this equipment will not be maintained or replaced by the District.

Staff will implement technology applications that expand the connection between home and school at all levels and across every classroom through ongoing staff development opportunities.
