 - i. Measurement moved from CAASPP testing in 18-19 school year (the last year we had scores) to now using iReady scores
 - ii. School-wide goals are established as a school site by looking at prior data and patterns from years before
 - iii. There is a big jump in scores: Ex: English Language Arts: School wide- As measured by spring 2021 iReady Reading diagnostic data, 80% of students will be performing at or above grade-level. Students currently performing at or above grade-level is 67%. They will have 1 year’s growth to meet the 80% goal.
 - iv. Grade-level teams created their own grade-level goals along with strategies to support their goals using historical and current data and date trends.
 - v. Question and discussion on supporting students with Phonics since that also was noted as an area of need
 - vi. Some strategies were blacked out- discovered this happened due to the copy + paste feature.
