

Acrylic Knife Painting

Winter 2019 Supply List

Instructor: Naomi Lesberg

We begin painting on day one, so please bring the following supplies.

If you are a continuing student, you already know what you need. Bring what you're working on.

Paints: Any red, yellow, and blue that you like, plus white (or white gesso) and other classes you love. **Not Michaels Artist's Loft or craft paint).** **Tube (thick) paint is needed.**

Tools: At least one palette knife (plastic or metal).

Palette: A disposable paper palette or coated paper plates or any similar non-porous flat surface on which to place and mix your paint. Large plastic cottage cheese lids are great.

Supports: At least one sheet of 8" x 10" or larger watercolor paper (90 lb. or heavier) and two or more pre-stretched canvas or canvas boards (also called canvas panels). Larger is better than smaller!

An image you want to paint!

Miscellaneous:

Roll of paper towels

Small spray bottle for water

Small bottle of rubbing alcohol for cleaning up spills or mistakes

Apron, smock, or wear "dress for mess" clothes.

Optional: **Any gel medium if your paint is too watery.**

Where to buy supplies? Artist & Craftsman Supply (Hillcrest), Dick Blick (San Diego), Michaels (everywhere), JoAnn Fabric, Walmart. There are many online sources and catalogues, such as Cheap Joe's, Jerry's Artarama, Amazon, etc. Check the travel section of places like Walmart for little plastic containers.
