

## **Acrylic Mixed Media**

Winter II 2022 Supply List

**Instructor:** Naomi Lesberg

During this 3-week class, you will be exploring ways to combine paint with other media, especially water-soluble drawing media and collage, and use them on different surfaces. The goal is to expose you to new creative possibilities while having fun. Choosing a theme could be helpful: Collect words and images! Some examples: flowers, family, holidays, animals, landscapes.

### **Please bring:**

- Canvas panels or stretched canvas, in sizes you like for. You may also use heavyweight watercolor or mixed media paper. It's only a 3-week class so you don't need much, but larger is better than smaller.
- Your usual acrylic or watercolor painting supplies: paints, brushes, knives, palettes, water containers, etc.—whatever you usually use when you paint.
- Water-soluble drawing materials, such as watercolor colored or graphite pencils, Woody 3 in 1s, pastels, etc.
- Fabric scraps and/or patterned scrapbook paper for collages.
- Masking tape or painters' tape.
- Acrylic medium (matte or gloss) or Elmer's glue, Tacky glue, etc.
- Paper towels.
- Small spray bottle for water.
- Apron, smock, or wear "dress for mess" clothes.
- If you have art you want to work on, bring it! If you have a "failed" painting or one that you're not sure what to do with, that's even better! Bring it also!

If you are a continuing student, you already know what you need. Bring what you're working on. You will have time, and you will get help.

**If you're not sure about supplies, please check with me first before buying anything.**

**Where to buy supplies?** Artist & Craftsman Supply (Hillcrest), Dick Blick (Little Italy), Walmart, Michaels, and Joann Fabric & Craft. (Note: Michaels and Joann honor each other's coupons.) There are many online sources and catalogues, too, such as Cheap Joe's, Jerry's Artarama, and Amazon.
