

Spectator's Code of Conduct



At Del Norte High School. Good Sportsmanship is one of the primary purposes of educational athletics.

Guidelines to good sportsmanship are as follows:

- Spectators must recognize that judgment calls – by coaches and officials are made in good faith and should be respected.
- Spectators should exercise great sportsmanship based on six core principles:
 - ✓ Trustworthiness
 - ✓ Respect
 - ✓ Responsibility
 - ✓ Fairness
 - ✓ Caring
 - ✓ Good Citizenship
- No Taunting players, coaches, or officials.
- No person should use words or actions that could provoke a (violent) response.
- Do Not approach, confront, or question a coach or an official before, during or after a contest.
- No person shall intimidate or threaten another person.
- Spectators can support their team by cheering in a positive manner.
- Spectators can support both teams by refraining from derogatory or demeaning comments or cheers.
- Failure to adhere to the above will result in the spectator being escorted out of the Del Norte High School events at home or away.
- Any violation will be enforced throughout the school year, and a meeting with the Del Norte Administration must be held prior to returning to another Del Norte event.
