#### FAVORITE TECH TOOL

I really enjoy using Flip! (formerly Flipgrid) with my students. This is a video-sharing tool where the teacher creates a topic to spark discussion within the classroom. Our students are able to post and then comment on each other's video entries. It's so awesome to see my students' creativity come to life on the screen. Quiet students are able to express themselves in a way that often surprises me.

### **TECH TIP**

I love using Thrively with my 4th grade students. We are really focusing on unpacking our strengths, with the initial Strength Assessment and the 23 Thrively Strengths playlist. As my scholars are learning more about their strengths, they are also discovering how their classmates have other strengths and how these apply to their daily learning. We also use this vocabulary to help us understand the characters in our literature selections. We can truly understand resilience, assertiveness, creative thinking, and more as we unpack these strengths within ourselves and then apply them to the people we are reading about.
