

## BEHAVIOR AT ESS

## \*\* One Per Family

While your child is at ESS, he/she is expected to follow all school and ESS rules. Our rules focus on the six pillars of Character Counts to help the child make better choices. The six pillars are trustworthiness, respectfulness, responsibility, fairness, caring, and citizenship. Children not cooperating will lose privileges and may not be able to participate in future activities. Please review and sign this with your child.

As noted in our parent handbook, our behavior management plan is as follows:

Level 1: Child may be redirected, verbally warned or removed from an activity.

Level 2: Child may be placed on a behavior plan/chart for 3-4 weeks with parent communication.

Level 3: Will result in a 1 day suspension on the next scheduled day of attendance and requires a parent/supervisor conference.

Level 4: Any further occurrences of inappropriate behavior will result in a 3 day suspension and conference with the Supervisor and Director.

Level 5: Continued inappropriate behavior will lead to a 5 day suspension with any additional behavior leading to termination from the program. A conference with the Supervisor and Director is required to return to ESS.

\*Any behavior resulting in aggression towards staff and/or participants will immediately proceed to Level 4; severe behavior will proceed directly to level 5.

## EXPECTATIONS

### BATHROOM EXPECTATIONS

- Only one student in a stall at a time.
- Flush toilet only once after you use it.
- Use quiet voices in the restroom.
- Use faucet water to wash hands only.
- Paper towels are used to dry hands only.
- Throw used paper towels into the trash can.

### PLAYGROUND EXPECTATIONS

- I will show respect to all adults who supervise the playground.
- I understand that all games are open to any student at ESS.
- I will not bully another student, fight another student, spit, swear, or throw rocks or sand anywhere on the playground. I understand that any of these behaviors could get me sent home or suspended after my parents have been contacted.
- I will eat my snack in the designated snack area. Food is not to be eaten anywhere else on the playground.
- The backboards are for handball only. Balls should not be bounced against the building walls.
- I will play respectfully on the playground. I understand that there is no rough play.

### PLAYGROUND EQUIPMENT EXPECTATIONS

- I will not play tag or chase on or near the playground equipment.
- I will slide down the slide one person at a time. I will slide down feet first in a sitting position.
- I will not climb on top of or jump off slide, swings or any other playground equipment.
- I will keep two hands on the bars at all times.

### ADDITIONAL REMINDERS..

During ESS activities, I will use a positive attitude and try my best at all times!

We have read the ESS expectations together and we understand what the expectations/consequences.
