Allow extra time please.

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 1:12 Adult to student ratio The same adult will remain with the group to the extent possible The students will remain with the same small group 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students from the same family will be in the same group if age span is appropriate Each group will meet in their own classroom One group at a time will use any community areas (multi-purpose rooms and playgrounds) 	
Health and Safety Guidelines to Set the Environment up for Success		Parent Initials
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Temperatures and a screening questionnaire will be taken on staff and students before they enter the facility A no touch thermometer will be used Anyone with a fever over 100 or showing signs of illness will not be admitted Families and staff are asked to self-screen at home for fevers and symptoms before coming to the facility Parents/Guardians will be asked to remain outside the facility and not enter the school site Masks will be worn by staff, parents/guardians and are optional for students Staff and students will practice 20 second hand washing and be required to wash their hands at specific times during the day Students within a group may play with common toys and use common materials, however they will be sanitized through out the course of the day 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Should a child develop a fever while under the program's care, the child will be moved to a supervised isolation area and parents will be called. <i>Parents/Guardians or the designated emergency contact must be able to pick up the child within 30 minutes.</i> A child who has had a fever may not re-enter the facility until they have been fever free (without medication) for 72 hours and must provide a Dr's note that they are cleared for attendance. Staff will be following OSHA and County guidelines for cleaning and disinfecting areas used by students and staff Custodians will be cleaning and disinfecting each classroom nightly

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students must bring all snack, lunch and drink supplies in labeled disposable containers clearly labeled with student name; food items will be disposed of after each meal 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Students must bring two disposable bottles of water that will be discarded at the end of each day Afternoon snacks will continue to be supplied by the program
