

PTA & Foundation Collaboration Roadmap

This year Pomerado Elementary followed the model set by Sunset Hills Elementary and created a collaborative effort which streamlined fundraising and volunteerism.

WHY?

The number one complaint from parents is fundraising fatigue. Most parents don't distinguish between Foundation and PTA and don't understand the need for two organizations.

ESTABLISH IDENTITIES

We established Foundation as the fundraising arm for our school and PTA as the service arm. Our goal was to build community by hosting low or no-cost events and streamlining our fundraising efforts.

HOW?

Step 1: Plan a Master Calendar Together.

We tried to keep money-asking events to once a month. This included no-profit events like Fall and Spring Pictures, Yearbook and the Book Fair. By considering how a typical family budgets, we actually increased participation in fundraising events. This year our Fall fundraiser was so successful we announced we would have no Spring fundraiser.

Step 2: Spread the Message.

During registration, the Welcome Back Breakfast and Back to School Night we delivered the message to parents that the PTA and Foundation were working together to create a collaborative partnership.

Foundation = Fundraising and PTA=Service & Programs

Step 3: Show the Love.

At every school assembly we --- the PTA president and the Foundation president --- thank the PTA volunteers and chairs for their service and thank the Foundation for providing funding. The PTA and Foundation presidents need to attend each others' meetings and both attend all events.
