Meadowbrook's staff are committed to supporting your child's academic needs with effective classroom instruction from our teachers and multiple opportunities for students to receive help in order to achieve success.

Our teachers provide student support in many areas:

- Teachers regularly update student grades through our [Synergy online system](#). Parents have access to view current and detailed grade reports on how their child is doing in each of their classes. *Note: Our elective teachers use [MyConnect's grade system](#).*
- Many of our teachers offer tutorial support before school, during lunch, or after school. Please refer to each teacher's classroom syllabus or contact them directly if you would like to know what tutorial support they may provide.
- Parents have access to our [MyConnect system](#) in which many teachers update their class calendars with daily classwork or homework assignments. Some of our teachers have their curriculum online to allow students and parents to view and download classroom handouts or supplemental materials.
- One of our school's professional development goals has been to study the work of John Hattie and his top 10 high-impact, evidence-based teaching strategies. Teachers developed lesson plans in which they incorporated John Hattie's research into their instruction. More information on the work of John Hattie can be [found here](#).

Our counseling department also provides academic support:

- Student and parents are welcome to contact our counselors to discuss a child's academic progress. Mrs. Mary Kay Knock (A-L), Ms. Lea Garza (M-Z), and Ms. Nicole Pablo provide one-on-one support on strategies for a student to gain more success in school. Parents are also welcome to meet with their child's counselor for any concerns they may be seeing from home.
- Our teachers, counselors, and administration regularly schedule Student Success Strategies (S3) meetings for students who are struggling in multiple academic areas. We invite the family of the student to these S3 meetings so that a support plan can be created and put in place in and out of the classroom. The goal of the support plan is to address all of the areas a student may be struggling in.
