Mt. Carmel High School participates in the Start Smart driving program. This requires that all students who want to apply for a MCHS parking permit must attend a free, two hour class, along with their parent or guardian. This class is taught by trained law enforcement officers. Topics include the possible consequences of distracted or impaired driving, collision prevention, and the restrictions of the Provisional License Law. Upon completion of this class by the student and parent, the student may apply for a MCHS parking permit.
