<p>PARKING LOT – <i>Student Parking Permit</i></p>	<p>If you plan to park in the parking lot, you must have a valid parking sticker on your car by no later than Friday, September 9 <u>or your car will be ticketed</u>. You can download the parking permit application from our website. Please see Ms. Adelman in the Admin. building to apply for a parking sticker before school, after school, snack or lunch. Student parking is designated by white stripes, staff parking has yellow stripes, and visitor parking is labeled. Students may park in designated student parking areas only.</p>
<p>LOCKS AND LOCKERS</p>	<p>Lockers – If you would like a locker, please visit Campus Safety before school, during break or lunch, or after school. You may not use any locker other than the one assigned to you. Mt. Carmel locks are available for purchase for \$7 at the Finance Office. If you do not wish to purchase a lock from Mt. Carmel, you may use your own lock. However, there may be times when school personnel will need to access your locker and, if you are using a non-Mt. Carmel lock, it may be necessary to cut off your lock to access your locker. <u>Mt. Carmel High School will not reimburse you for the cost of any locks that need to be cut.</u></p>
