


VISUAL ARTS COURSE DESCRIPTIONS

AP ART HISTORY

There is no prerequisite to this course, and it is encouraged for all grade levels 9-12. This course may be used to meet the UC "F" or "G" requirement and the PUSD Fine Arts requirement.
