We met this goal and were able to provide virtual connections for our students during this time of distance learning.</p> <p>Component 2- The Physical Environment</p> <p>Goal 1- With the assistance of our district office we were able to purchase all materials needed to meet this goal.</p> <p>Goal 2- Digital citizenship was an important goal to achieve. The baseline we used was the percentage of students that earned their high school math and English required credits.
