All supplies are voluntary and not required to participate in any school activity.

Parents, please feel free to use this list for suggested materials that will be helpful for your child during the start of the new year in a virtual setting. Individual teachers may work with students after the class begins for more specific items for their class.

6th Grade

- 1 spiral notebook per class (single subject '5 Star Type' / College Ruled)
- Pens/pencils
- 2 highlighters
- At least 2 dry erase markers + eraser
- Colored pencils
- 2 glue sticks
- Scissors
- Post-it Notes
- 3x5 index cards
- Decent quality earbuds/headphones (with microphone)

7th Grade

- 3 Ring Binder (1 1/2" please no zipper/trapper keeper style)
- Subject Tab Dividers (Pack of 5)
- College Ruled Notebook Paper
- Zipper Pouch **OR** Pencil Box/Supply Box to hold all supplies (i.e. pencils, scissors, pens, glue stick, etc.)
- Pens
- Pencils w/ erasers
- Glue Stick
- Highlighters
- Non-liquid white out
- Sticky Notes
- Earbuds/headphones
- Coloring tools - pens, pencils and/or markers
- Single Subject, College Ruled (8 1/2 X 11) Spiral Notebook (1 each for History and Social Studies)

8th Grade

- Multi-colored pens
