- We will use remaining funding to support Summer Bridge for incoming 9th graders who are at risk academically, or apprehensive about the transition to high school. The program is to teach study skills, reinforce math/English strategies and acclimate to the campus.
- We are committed to continuing our Equity and Inclusion work for all students at PHS: students of color, students who have special needs, mental challenges, and students who feel 'on the outside' for whatever reason. We are committed to showing every student– they are valuable, they matter, and they are certainly worth every effort we make to instill this. PHS staff commit to seeing and hearing our students, and making change happen.
