### **CONTINUING STUDENT REGISTRATION GRADES 10 - 12 - AUG 12 - 16**

Registration for students in grades 10 -12 will be held August 12 - 15 with make-ups on August 16. We will be prepared to register students only at their assigned date and time. Students may register anytime between 8:00 am - 12:20 pm on their assigned date as there is no "alpha" split this year.

Students need to come to Registration prepared to have their photo ID taken and to pick up their books. Please bring proper paperwork for parking permit (if needed.)

Sophomores - August 14 - 8:00 am - 12:20 pm

Sophomores please bring hearing devices for hearing screening, if necessary.

### **FRESHMAN REGISTRATION AND BRONCO CAMP - AUG. 15**

Welcome, Class of 2023! Your registration is Thursday, August 15. Students with last names A - L will register between 8:30 - 10:30 am and then attend Bronco Camp in the PAC from 11:00 am - 1:00 pm. Students with last names M - Z will attend Bronco Camp in the PAC from 8:30 - 10:30 am and will register between 11:00 am - 1:00 pm.

Freshmen, please be prepared to have your photo ID taken and to pick up your books.

### **REMOVAL OF LOCKERS**

Over the past several years, the conditions of the lockers in the locker bays has deteriorated. In addition, with recent curriculum adoptions and class sets of books in classrooms, students no longer need to bring textbooks back and forth from home thus lessening the need for a locker. In an effort to create more seating and covered space for students to sit and congregate, most of the lockers in the small quad have been removed.

A few lockers remain for those students with specific needs and will be assigned on an as needed basis once school begins. Students will also have a secured location to keep their athletic equipment during their season of sport. We are currently working with the RBHS Foundation to purchase additional seating in the bays for students to enjoy each other's

company and to connect. If you have questions or concerns, please contact one of our administrators.

### **PE CLOTHES**

PE clothes will be available for purchase at Freshman Registration. We accept cash or check payable to RBHS.

The Student Store is closing. Discounted PE clothes (shirt and shorts) and lock will be available for \$20.

Newly designed PE clothes (\$15 for shirts and \$15 for shorts) will be available for purchase. PE locks will also be available for \$7, or you can purchase your own.

## **TB TESTING FOR SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS**

Due to regulations from both the state and county, PUSD nurses will no longer be providing TB clearance for volunteers (due every four years.) The law requires that TB clearance be completed by a licensed health care provider. The provider will determine if risk factors exist and provide a TB test, if needed.
