

RBHS Math Placement Guidelines for 8th Graders

Rancho Bernardo High School operates on a block schedule known as a 4x4. Subject classes are completed in 18 week terms (2 quarters). This schedule allows students the opportunity to take eight classes during a school year which means they can take more than one math class during a single school year. It is an accelerated schedule so it is important students have strong foundations in mathematics before moving onto the next course.

Below are the recommendations for 8th grade students and parents when enrolling for 9th grade Math classes at RBHS.

***Note on students repeating Integrated 1 in high school:** Integrated 1 is the foundation for Integrated 2 and Integrated 3. It is recommended 8th grade students with a C or below in Integrated 1 repeat the course in high school to help insure success moving through the courses.

With the 4x4 schedule students enrolled in Integrated 1 their freshman year can still take an Advanced Placement (AP) level math course by their junior or senior year. (See RBHS Math Sequence)
