**Welcome to RB High!** You will receive your registration materials through your current school. It is important that you take these materials home and discuss them with your parents. **Please have your parents sign the Course Request Form (CRF) before you turn it back in to your teacher.**

- 1) Please read the Academic Planning Info available at [www.RBHS.org](http://www.RBHS.org) (academics menu/8th Grade). You will find that most of your questions are answered there. Sample schedules for band, AVID, and college bound students are all there. Your current teachers will be making their recommendations for your courses. Teachers are your best source of advice on what you are prepared to take next year.
- 2) Select courses from the CRF (paper). **Circle the COURSE NUMBERS.**
- 3) Your teacher will tell you when to login at [www.RBHS.org](http://www.RBHS.org) to input your classes into our computer database (Click the CRF Link in the announcements). Use your “CRF Online - Directions” (back side of this page) to follow step-by-step instructions for selecting your classes.
- 4) Teacher initials are required for English, math, science, and world language.
- 5) Academic classes (English, math, science, and world language) have 2 numbers, you must sign up for both to complete a year for college and graduation requirements (2 numbers = 1 year of the curriculum, but you finish both in 1 Term, either Fall or Spring).
- 6) Classes that have 1 number can be taken for a single quarter. Example: health or some art classes.
- 7) 8th graders are advised to take English, math, science, physical education (2 quarters), and 1 quarter of health.
- 8) We expect all 8th graders to take world language during the freshman or sophomore year.
- 9) **We cannot guarantee elective choices. NUMBER 3 alternate choices, or elective changes may be chosen for you. Enter only your first choice online, but list alternates on your CRF (by numbering your 3 preferences with 1 being most desired).**
- 10) All incoming 9th grade students are expected to enroll in a course of study that will help prepare them for college. Therefore, students should enroll in courses listed on the UC a-g list. The entire RBHS a-g list may be accessed at <https://hs-articulation.ucop.edu/agcourselist#/list/search/all>. Classes are also listed by a-g categories on your CRF.
