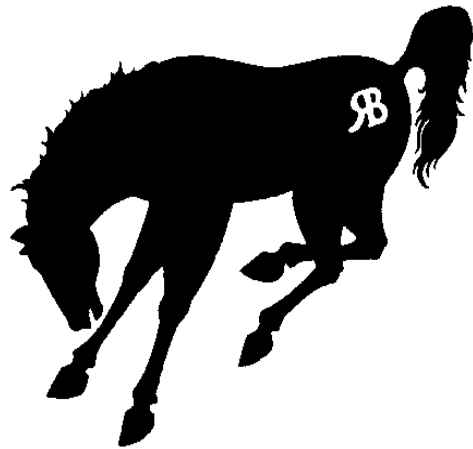

Cumulative Grades

6 wks = progress notice

12 wk = progress notice

18 wk = GRADE (permanent)

GRADES NEVER START OVER

Finals cover entire semester!!

2. Impact GPA
3. Impact Eligibility
4. Will give you credit toward graduation.
5. Must retake in Summer School for College admissions.

F

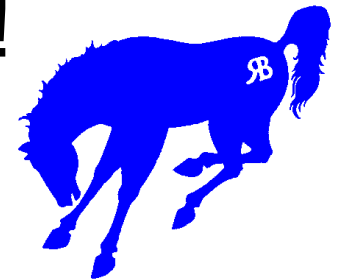
1. Colleges and Universities will not accept grade

4. Lose 5 CREDITS toward graduation!
5. Must retake course in Summer School to graduate on time!
6. Multiple F's=

Freshman Classes / CRF

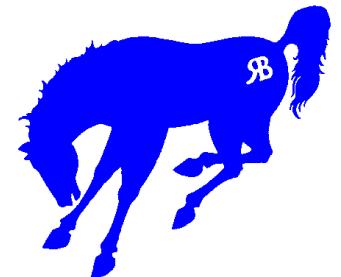
All 9th graders take 6 classes or more

- World Language or Electives (2 sem)
