This is an application for you to run for a position on the 2019 –2020 Associated Student Body (ASB). There are FOUR positions open at the 6th grade level. If you are selected as one of the top ten candidates, you will be scheduled in the ASB class as your RAM for the 2019-2020 school year.

**To be eligible to run for office, you must:**

- Have appropriate work habits and citizenship grades (No N's or U's)
- Meet the GPA requirement (3.0 or higher)
- No Disciplinary record on file (acts that have resulted in suspension, or multiple detentions)
- Understand that I must assist and/or be present at all ASB functions. Giving up some of my lunch, coming in before or after school, and/or attending nighttime functions as student leaders is part of the job.

**In order for your application to be considered, do the following:**

- Complete and turn in this application
- Complete and attach your ASB Application Essay (Prompt attached)
- Give to ALL 6 teachers the recommendation forms (Forms attached - confidential)
  - If you have one teacher for multiple subjects, please write **all** subjects for which you have this teacher on the Teacher Evaluation Form.

**Do not** start campaigning until Ms. Keller approves your application. There are very specific guidelines for campaigning. You will receive information when your application is approved. You will be notified no later than **Friday, September 6th, 2019.**

Campaigning for the election will be the week of **September 9<sup>th</sup>**, with the election taking place on **Friday, September 13<sup>th</sup>** in RAM.

**If you are elected to a position as an ASB representative, you will be a part of the ASB class, which will take the place of your RAM.** *By signing below, you are accepting full responsibility for attending and participating in all ASB related events and activities that will be expected of you if you are chosen as an ASB representative. Please do not take this commitment lightly.*
