That presentation is translated into 10 different languages and those translations will be posted on the District website, along with other important information. Our Adult School offers ESL classes for parents, our Caring Connections program offers parenting workshops and counseling opportunities, each school site provides training for parents to volunteer at the school, and the District EL Program Coordinator provides training opportunities for parents to help in our district as interpreters.
