## Dance Contract

### 2019-2020

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All dance attendees and their parents and/or guardians must read and agree to abide by the following dance policies and procedures. Your signatures on the registration consolidation signature page represents acceptance of the terms listed below:

#### **Entrance & Departure:**

- Students must have a current high school picture identification card (ID), California ID or other valid identification (passport, military ID, etc...).
- Any student bringing a guest who is not an DNHS student must present a completed guest pass to purchase a ticket for that guest and to enter into the dance.
- Students must obtain their own transportation to and from the dance.
- All students must arrive to the dance no later than one hour after the start of the dance.
- No outside food, drink, or liquids of any kind will be permitted. All non-permitted items that are confiscated will not be returned.
- All attendees of the dance must leave the dance or be picked up within 15 minutes from the conclusion of the dance.
- Re-Entry is not permitted
- Refunds are unavailable.

#### **Student Searches and Conduct:**

- All school rules pertaining to conduct apply.
- To purchase a dance ticket, students need to have completed all assigned Friday schools.
- All Del Norte High School students and guests are subject to random breathalyzer testing for alcohol or testing based upon reasonable suspicion at any school activity. Refusal to take a breath test will result in the student being denied entrance into the school event. No refund will be given. If a student is found to have alcohol in his/her system, the student will be released to his/her parent and is subject to disciplinary action. Disciplinary actions may include suspension, possible involuntary transfer to another school, or expulsion. (Per California Education Code #48900)
- All students are subject to search of pockets, purses, jackets, and other possessions. It is recommended that students bring as few possessions/valuables as possible to avoid loss or theft. Bags larger than a half sheet of paper (5.5in x 8.5 in.) will not be allowed in to the dance. (The law provides school officials with wide latitude to search students, their possessions and automobiles in the ongoing effort to maintain a safe and secure environment and facility for all students. In the event that inappropriate item(s), illegal substances, etc., are found in a student's possession, parents, guardians, and/or local authorities may be contacted and the students will be asked to leave the premises. Additional discipline, in accordance with California Educational Code and Poway Unified School District policy, may be imposed.)
- Sexually explicit and any dancing which may result in disruption or injury (i.e. moshing) is prohibited.  
**Note: Dance will end immediately with no refunds given if inappropriate dancing is taking place!**

#### **Dress Guidelines:**

- All school rules pertaining to dress code apply.
- Students must wear closed toe shoes at all times.
