

WATER OR LACK OF, WHAT IS THE DISTRICT DOING?

1. All non-essential irrigation is being shut off
2. Conform to the drought restrictions provided by the water suppliers
3. Irrigation to playfields will be three days per week
4. Report all leaks immediately and repair within 72 hours
5. Develop a landscape plan utilizing drought tolerant plantings
6. Investigate new products to incorporate into existing play fields to hold moisture
7. Stay in communication with water suppliers on drought conditions
8. Investigate newer technology in smart irrigation controllers

District staff maintains all school landscape areas across the District's 100 square miles. To irrigate all of these areas, the District has hundreds of watering stations and valves and thousands of sprinklers. Even the best and newest systems can malfunction or even fail.
