ADVANCED PLACEMENT AGREEMENT



Students at Poway High School who plan to attend a college or university following graduation from high school are highly encouraged to complete one or more Advanced Placement (AP) courses during their high school career. These courses are dynamic, rigorous, college-level classes that are designed to help students prepare for a successful post high school experience.

The Course Request Form (CRF) measures student interests and determines whether or not a course will be offered the following year. In 2023-2024, we hope to offer the following Advanced Placement courses at Poway High School – World History, US History, US Government & Politics, Human Geography, English Language, English Literature, Environmental Science, Biology, Chemistry, Physics C, Statistics, Calculus AB, Calculus BC, Studio Art, Psychology, French, German, Spanish Language, Spanish Literature, Computer Science A, and Computer Science Principles.

Advanced Placement courses require students to approach their work very seriously. The effort required by students is greater than that required for comparable non-AP classes. Students are encouraged to carefully consider which courses are best suited to individual interests. It is also recommended that students consider their prior academic record, extracurricular activities, and home or work responsibilities prior to deciding the number of AP courses appropriate for them.

Please select your classes carefully. Staffing decisions are made based upon student requests. Therefore, once a student requests enrollment in an Advanced Placement course, a student will *not* be dropped from the class based solely upon a student or parent request. When a student requests enrollment in an Advanced Placement course, a seat is set aside for that student. Students are expected to honor their commitment. As courses fill for the school year, seats may be limited when trying to move from AP to Non-AP classes and this could adversely affect the student’s schedule.

We congratulate you on accepting the AP challenge. We believe that you will be a more successful college or university student because of these experiences.
