- b. Login with your ID number, Last name, and birthdate.
- c. You may nominate for as many, or few, categories as you want.
- d. Each student is given up to 4 nominations per category: 2 for boys and 2 for girls, although you can choose to alter this if you want.
- e. No student can "win" more than one category (with the exception of best friends) so be sure to vary your nominations.
- f. You will select from a list of all 8th graders for all categories except for the 2 "Best Friends" categories. For these two categories you will write in your nominations.
- g. Possible categories may include: Best Friends, Future Comedian, Nicest Eyes, Brightest Smile, Future Famous Musician, Most Fun to be Around, Best Dressed, Best Laugh, Nicest Personality, Biggest Fan Girl/Boy, Would Take
