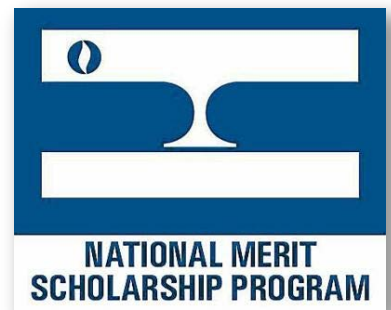

Each student will receive between \$500 and \$2,000 annually, for up to four years of undergraduate study at the institution financing the scholarship. They were judged to have the strongest combination of accomplishments, skills, and potential for success. Officials of each sponsor college selected their scholarship winners from among the finalists in the NMSC Program who will attend their institution.

About the National Merit Scholarship Program

Over 1.5 million juniors in approximately 21,000 high schools entered the 2020 National Merit Scholarship Program. The majority of National Merit Scholarships offered each year are underwritten by some 400 independent corporate and college sponsors that support NMSC's efforts to honor the nation's scholastically talented youth and encourage academic excellence at all levels of education.
